Building on the rich history of youth skiing and ski racing at Pico Mountain, the **Pico Ski Education Foundation** is dedicated to maintaining affordable access for athletes to pursue their skiing dreams. Established in 1977, PSEF provides funding for purchases needed by the Pico Ski Club in order to run well-equipped, affordable training and racing activities at Pico Mountain. PSEF also provides annual merit scholarships and offers scholarship support to PSC athletes who qualify for elite regional events.

In 2013, PSEF was thrilled to announce the opening of the Andrea Mead Lawrence Lodge. Through a vigorous fundraising campaign in collaboration with Vermont Adaptive Ski and Sports, the Andrea Mead Lawrence Lodge now stands as the year-round hub of activity for Vermont Adaptive Ski and Sports, and home to the Pico Ski Club Race Program. This new training center allows a greater level of programming, physical and academic athletic training, and team-building to children of all ages and abilities.

Fundraising for the Andrea Mead Lawrence Lodge Campaign is an ongoing process. The completion of this training facility fulfills a dream for the ski club program to expand dryland training, technical and educational facilities for its coaches and athletes, and to promote team building, confidence and inspiration among participants.

The **Pico Ski Club Racing Program** is a *Club Level* Youth Skiing Program located at Pico Mountain. The Racing Program, since its inception in 1949, embraces its role of developing great skiers and skiing families, not just racers, from very early ages right up through high school; teaching technical skills, fostering self-discovery, healthy competitiveness and an appreciation for the spirit of skiing, family, friendship and mountain life.

Club Level is a designation which means that the Program does not generally include academics, housing or other school model offerings. Student athletes typically live at home and enroll in their local schools. Club Level also means that most of the operation and administration of the Program is done on a volunteer basis.
